

The Jean Crawford Cochrane Scholarship Application Form 2022-23

The scholarship, to commemorate Jean Crawford Cochrane, is for the purpose of encouraging women to further their education through an undergraduate degree course at Queen's, an opportunity which may have been limited, due to financial constraints.

Preference will be given to women normally coming from the post-primary education system in Northern Ireland, on the basis of a student's verified household income (usually under £20,000), who have a place on the first year of a full-time undergraduate degree course at Queen's University Belfast.

For your application to be considered all relevant sections of the form must be completed. All information will be treated confidentially. (See Notes for Guidance attached)
