£7.5m advanced manufacturing technology facility



The 2018 Global Peace Index – the world's leading measure of global peacefulness – has been launched at Queen's Management School at Riddel Hall.

The Index covers 99.7 per cent of the world's population and ranks 163 countries, using 23 qualitative and quantitative indicators.



British Isles under ice 2.5 million years ago

New evidence from ancient seafloors suggests ice sheets covered much of the UK and Ireland from 2.5m years ago – over 1m years earlier than previously thought!

Breakthrough research indicates the British Isles were repeatedly submerged under ice nearly 300m high, extending to the centre of the North Sea.

Five students from Queen's, each with proven track records of community service, have been on the trip of lifetime to the US as part of the 2018 Washington Ireland Programme.



Queen's climbs up QS World University Rankings

The recently issued QS University World Rankings list Queen's in the Top 200 of worldwide universities for 2019 – a climb of 22 places on last year!

Regarded as one of the most prestigious international listings, the system assesses over 4,000 institutions, from almost 90 countries and ranks the world's top 1,000.



Brexit at the border

A major report by Queen's researchers reveals that residents living in impacted areas of Ireland - north and south - want the border to remain 'seamless' and 'frictionless'.

The report also found that more information has led to increased fears of a 'hard border', with 60 per cent of respondents believing that is it more likely than previously thought.

Risks lowest in light alcohol drinkers

While the combined risk of cancer or death is lowest in light drinkers, the latest research from Queen's suggests that the rates of some cancers increase with each additional alcoholic drink consumed per week.

In the study, each participant's alcohol use was measured using a diet history questionnaire administered between the years 1998 and 2001.
