Bero is Chair of Medicines Use and Health Outcomes at the School of Pharmacy and Director of the Evidence Policy and Influence Collaborative, Charles Perkins Centre, University of Sydney. She is an expert in examining how science can influence and be translated into clinical practice and health policy. She has developed and validated methods for assessing bias in the design, conduct and dissemination of research on pharmaceuticals, tobacco, chemicals, and complex public health interventions. She is currently Senior Editor, Cochrane Public Health and Health Systems Network. Her international activities include member and chair of the World Health Organization (WHO) Essential Medicines Committee and Cochrane Collaboration liaison to WHO.
